PROPERTY: Property taxes are determined by tax rates and assessment ratios, which vary by location. The only realistic way to compare properry raxes for different locations is to use "effective tax rates" (tax rate multiplied by assessment ratio).

Effective tax rates combine city, county, school, and state tax rates into one convenient figure — the yearly tax for each \$1,000 of property at its fair market value. This rate applies to all property, land, building, machinery, equipment, inventory.


